

❖ VMLIP Online University

Through the VMLIP Online University members have the opportunity to expand their training in the areas of health, safety and human resources. The university provides a comprehensive training curriculum of courses, which are free to members and available 24/7/365. Several may be eligible for continuing Professional Education Units for water and wastewater operators.

❖ Risk Management Guidelines

Risk Management Guidelines (RMG) help members assess their risk management efforts by generating a score, focusing on areas such as program oversight, claims management, fleet safety, self-inspections, workshop and training attendance, safety awareness and more.

Through the RMG members are helped in focusing their risk management efforts and tracking their progress toward reaching 100 percent. Members scoring 100 percent may be eligible to receive a five percent credit on their annual premiums if other applications criteria are met.

❖ Services

VML Insurance Programs (VMLIP) provides safety consultative services as well as a wide variety of tools to help members develop, implement and maintain effective risk management programs.

Experienced safety consultants are available to provide on-site consultation and facility assessments, program and policy review, and free risk management trainings and workshops held on-site, online and regionally.

Additional services include 24/7 access to a variety of FREE online and e-services, including:

- VMLIP Online University web-based training;
- Risk Management Guideline (RMG) assessment tool;
- Training and reference resources;
- Webinars and regional risk management workshops;
- Sample policies on a wide range of topics; and
- Bulletins for use in training and risk management communications.

❖ Modules

VMLIP provides more than 30 program development and training modules to members. Each customizable module contains a sample written program, board/council resolution, management announcement letter, copies of applicable regulation(s) or standard(s), and extensive employee training and support materials. Topics include:

❖ VMLIP Multimedia Library

VMLIP offers members a free lending library consisting of videos, DVD's, CD's and printed materials covering a variety of topics relating to safety. The library catalog provides the title, running time (for multimedia materials), and a summary of primary elements addressed by the presentation.

❖ Risk Management Grants

VMLIP members are eligible for grant funds to further develop their risk management program. Grants can be used to purchase safety equipment, attend training sessions, and to use for educational endeavors aimed at broadening member understanding of governmental risk management.

Members are eligible for grant funding based on their Risk Management Guideline Tier and lines of coverage. Members who participate in all coverage lines are eligible for the greatest benefit. Grant funds are available on a first come first serve basis.
